

**2007 EUROMED SUMMIT OF ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCILS AND
SIMILAR INSTITUTIONS
15- 16 October 2007
Athens, Greece**

Based on the EESC delegation visit to Egypt on September 11th, 2007 and their meeting with the civil society organizations representatives (Trade unions, Businessmen, Labors, farmers and NGO... etc.) organized by the Arab reform forum, Bibliotheca Alexandrina. To discuss the establishment of a permanent dialogue between the EuroMed and the Egyptian civil Society under the umbrella of Bibliotheca Alexandrina and to put the foundations for an Egyptian Economic and Social Council like all Euromed and Arab countries.

Since the Euromed Summit of Economic and Social Councils was on October 15-16th, 2007. A steering committee met on October 13th, 2007 and nominated the potential names that could participate at the Summit.
