






- Master and doctor fellows by many different scholarships, e.g. DAAD, Erasmus program ...
- ➤ For outstanding students who got doctor degree in land: grant to go to other land as a postdoctoral researchers and gain international experiences
- For outstanding foreign students, many scholarships to come as a guest scientist, e.g. Humboldt scholarship, Einstein scholarship ...
- For brilliant scientists, national or international, starting grant to build a research group, e.g. young investigator research grant by Helmholtz society ...
 - Managements workshop: group and time management
 - Professional coaching
 - Tutor coaching
