My Book: Digital and Printed Project



The Bibliotheca Alexandrina has provided this project via a mobile unit in order to spread the idea and encourage children to read. Thus, a presentation is given accompanied by an explanation of the printing process. Then, the children create a small booklet.

Eligibility

The school must have a playground for the car to enter the school, to allow students to see the processes a book has to go through.



Visit Goals

- 1) Encourage children to read.
- 2) Create a connection between different sources of knowledge, such as books, computers, and internet.
- 3) Encourage the use of computers.
- 4) Allow the children to get used to searching different resources.

Storytelling and Crafts (Arabic or English Languages



This activity is presented to 6 to 8 year old children. It is storytelling in a brand new way, and then an artwork related to it is implemented.
