Who can participate?

Anybody 16 years old and above.

What should I submit?

You should submit a poster with the following specifications:

- 1- The poster should contain at least one text related to the novel *Fahrenheit 451*. It can be a selection of the novel, a summary, a comment, an essay about the novel, creative writing inspired by the novel, etc.
- 2- The texts should be written in English, Arabic or French.
- 3- At least one text should be your own writing.
- 4- If you use texts or illustrations by others, you should give an exact indication of the source, whether it is a book, a magazine, or a website.
- 5- The poster should contain graphical elements or illustrations. These may be created manually or with computer aid.
- 6- The poster should contain a title related to the novel.
- 7- The work's dimensions should not exceed 50 x 70 cm.
- 8- The submitted work should be original and created by the participant; it should not be copied from other works.
- 9- Each participant can submit one work only.

The contest committee has the right to refuse any works not following the terms of the contest.

How should I submit my work?

Please submit your work to the reference desk on the first floor (F1) of the Bibliotheca Alexandrina. You will be asked to complete a personal data form.

In case you submit computer-aided work, you need to submit a CD with a soft copy of your work.

When should I submit my works?

Anytime during the Library opening hours, from 14 to 30 July.

What about the prizes?

5 prizes will be awarded to the best posters. The winners will get a book and a certificate. The finalists will be announced during the Big Read summer celebration on 13 August 2009. On this occasion, all accepted works will be exhibited.

The Bibliotheca Alexandrina will take photos of all accepted works, in order to publish them in electronic format on the website of **The Big Read**.
