Who can participate?

Anybody (professionals or amateurs) 16 years old and above.

What can I submit?

- 1- You can submit paintings or prints.
- 2- The work should be related to the novel.
- 3- The work's dimensions should not exceed 70 cm x 1 m.
- 4- You should give your work a title indicating its relationship to the novel.
- 5- The submitted work should be original and created by the participant; it should not be copied from other works.
- 6- Each participant can submit one work only.
- 7- None of the submitted works should have previously been awarded prizes in other contests.
- 8- You should submit your work in a format which allows direct display in the Big Read exhibition (e.g. in a simple frame).

The contest committee has the right to refuse any work that does not follow the above contest terms.

How should I submit my work?

Please submit your work at the reference desk on the second basement (B2) at the Bibliotheca Alexandrina. You will be asked to complete a personal data form, and to sign a statement concerning the Bibliotheca Alexandrina's rights in dealing with the submitted works.

When should I submit my works?

Anytime during the Library opening hours, from 1 August to 15 November 2010.

What about the prizes?

Five awards will be given to the winners. Each winner will receive an illustrated book and a certificate. Finalists will be announced in November 2010.
