The Bibliotheca Alexandrina (BA) offers its users an extensive collection of electronic resources (free of charge) through its subscriptions.

It provides access to numerous full text e-journal and e-book titles in addition to a massive number of e-theses and dissertations, multimedia resources, and more. To access the Library's electronic resources collection, you can do the following:


- Use the Library computers: Select “electronic resources” from the left menu on the internal interface.




