Highlight the importance of raising awareness about ChatGPT and its potential for students and researchers.

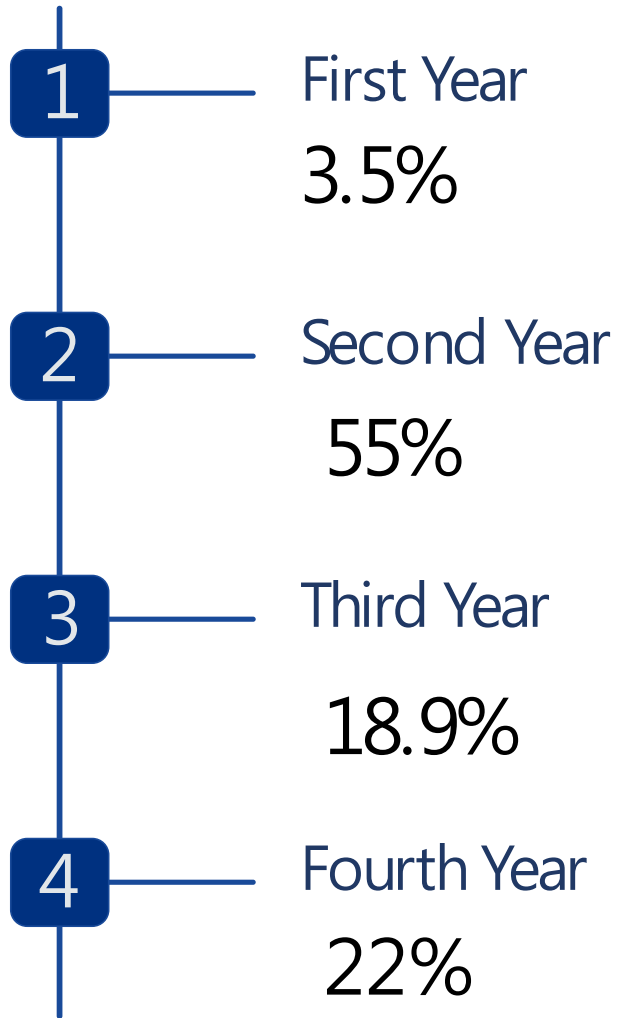
Academic Guidance

43.2% of students did not use AI tools, citing lack of awareness, difficulty creating accounts, and reliance on internet sources.

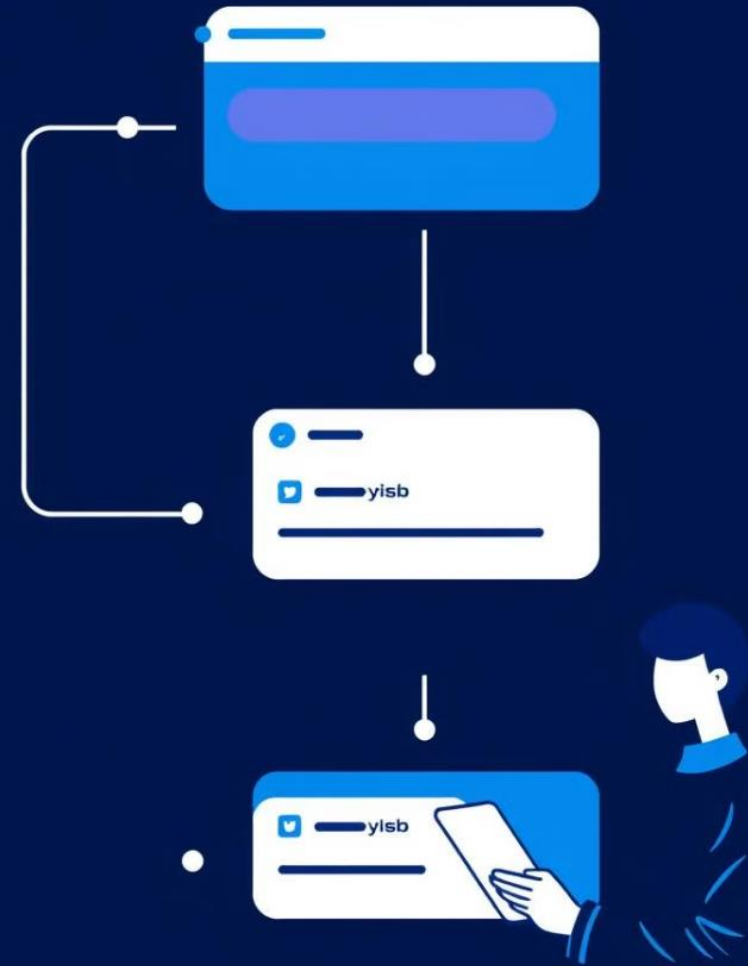
60.2% of students used ChatGPT for assignments.

Result Satisfaction

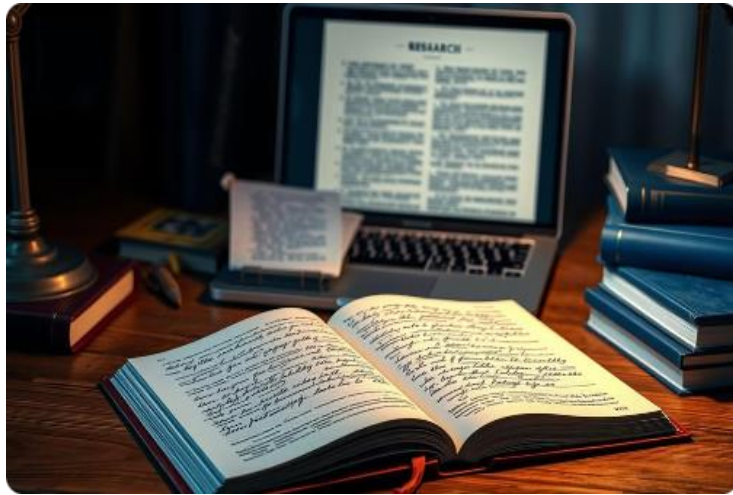
69.5% of students were satisfied with ChatGPT results.
