



The Bibliotheca Alexandrina organizes a Cultural Debate on “Literature and Cultural Fields in Egypt,” at Bayt Al-Sinnari

15th July, 2014 - In association with the European Union, the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, is holding a debate that brings together a selection of prominent Egyptian authors, scholars and literature specialists on Saturday July 19th to discuss the nature of literary movements in novels, short stories, poetry and its effect on the shaping of the Egyptian literature.

The session also aims to discuss how literature is reflecting the current situation in Egypt. The meeting will be attended by a wide selection of Egyptian authors and critics. Moreover, it will discuss, in another session, the situation of cultural journalism in Egypt. The meeting will also be hosting new youth experiences in this field.

This debate comes as part of the Cultural Diversity and Creativity in Egypt Program, which is funded by the European Union, and is carried out by the Bibliotheca Alexandrina in association with the Ministry of Culture, the Ministry of Education and Higher Education and the Ministry of External Affairs.
