

About 30 years ago

- Word "epidemiology" in Russia was related only to infectious diseases while epidemic of noncommunicable diseases already starts.

- It become possible for Russian scientists to participate in International scientific programs as MONICA (global trends in CVD).



Interlibrary Loan system in USSR

- In Soviet union (wiki) as of 1973, the Interlibrary Loan system included more than 60,000 libraries. Readers received books for work by order through local libraries. It was possible to obtain domestic and foreign books in originals, microfilms or copies.
- It was time of letters, Telegrams, phones and later faxes






Current status for training in statistics Russia






2.1. Статистика как самостоятельная общественная наука





We were originally funded three times by NASA, and by the National Library of Medicine. We have built a "Library of Lectures" with passionate scientific lectures from across the world. We have developed a technology for inexpensive, sustainable global training. More information on our program.





- During 2015 we collected all the faculty in most of Universities in Africa and Arab World. In addition we are collecting faculty in our 6 main areas of science. We had 54,243 E-mails from African and 28,775 from Arabic countries.
- By February 2016 we identified 847,060 unique E-mail addresses of scientists of the world.






