## From Rare Islamic Coins A unique dinar struck in Nysabour during 343 AH/954 CE, in the name of Ahmed ibn Mohammed

Abu Ali Ahmed ibn Mohammed was one of the most powerful figures on the political scene during the reign of Samanid Prince Nuh ibn Nasr. The research includes a study and analysis of the sole dinar belonging to him. The dinar was minted in Nysabour with the name of Abbasid Caliph al-Muti lillah. This dinar ensures that Ahmed ibn Mohammed ruled Khorasan during 343 AH, as independent ruler. In this research, I will analyze the inscriptions of this dinar in the light of the contemporary historical resources to reach new outcomes, which will be a valuable addition to Abbasid and Samanid coins in particular, and Islamic coins in general.
