Inscriptions of Generalife

Generalife is located in the east northern part of Alhambra Palace. It was built by Mohammed III ben Al-Ahmar, finished and decorated by Abu EI-Walid Isma'il Farag.

The research includes a descriptive study of the inscriptions of the Palace walls, which includes various poetry verses attributed to the Vizier Abu El Hassan Aly Ebn El Gayab from Granada. In addition, the research includes a detailed analytical study of inscriptions; which are written in Kufic and Thuluth scripts, accompanied by facsimile of all inscriptions.
