Abstract

The city of Magnessa is one of the oldest historical cities in western Anatolian region, and was the rural capital of western Anatolia, it was once called 'Maginisa', the city flourished during the sarokhan and Ottoman periods, and the in the Ottoman era was known as the city of Shahzada, because it was a training center for ottoman crown princes. It was a very important city, so the architectural activities flourished during the sarokhan and Ottoman periods, and during those periods numerous of structures were constructed and decorated with foundational and renewal texts and Prayer statements.
